



Boulders Lose in Ottawa, Season Ends Swept Out of Atlantic Conference Finals

UNDATED – The Boulders' 2026 season came to an end Friday night at Ottawa Stadium with a 3-2 Game Three loss to the Titans, who completed a sweep of the Frontier League's Atlantic Conference Finals.

New York fell behind in the first inning for the third time in the series, as 2B Jackie Urbaez was hit by a pitch to lead things off, moved to second base on a two-out walk, and scored from there on a wild pitch by LHP **Garrett Peters** (L, 0-1 / 4 IP, 3 R, 4 H, 3 BB, 0 K).

The Boulders had a golden opportunity to catch up in the top of the fourth, putting runners on second and third with one out before they left the bases loaded.

The Titans made it 3-0 in the bottom of the frame on DH Hunter Stokely's two-run single.

DH **Matt McDermott** got the visitors on the board with a leadoff homer in the fifth and SS **Austin Dennis** added an RBI single in the top of the seventh, but that was all the scoring the Boulders could muster.

Ottawa advances to the Frontier League Championship Series vs. the Evansville Otters or Washington Wild Things.

Washington stayed alive in the Midwest Conference Finals with a 4-1 win at home Friday night, cutting the Otters' series lead to 2-1.

The Boulders now wait to find out their next opponent -- for Opening Night in 2027 -- which will be in early May.

The Frontier League releases its inaugural National Association schedule on September 28th.
