



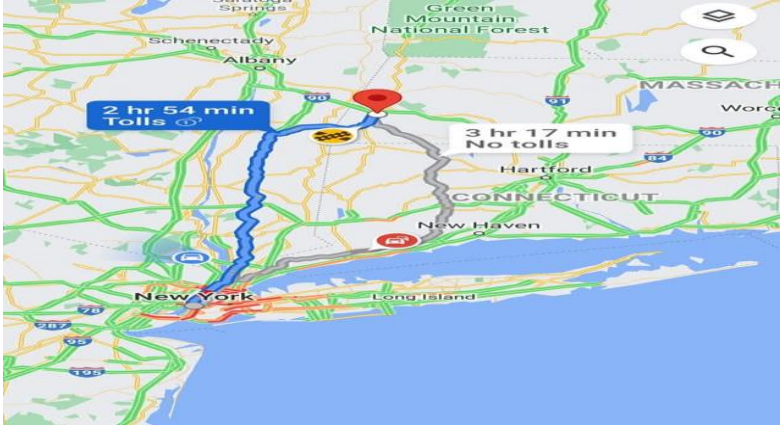
CHANGING SEASONS CHANGING LEAVES

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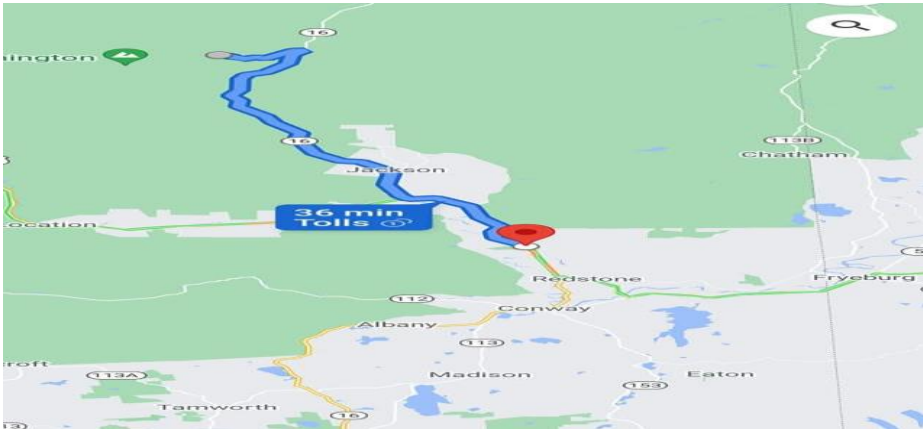


I just put this itinerary together for clients looking to see the changing leaves and more. Call it the Grand New England Circuit!

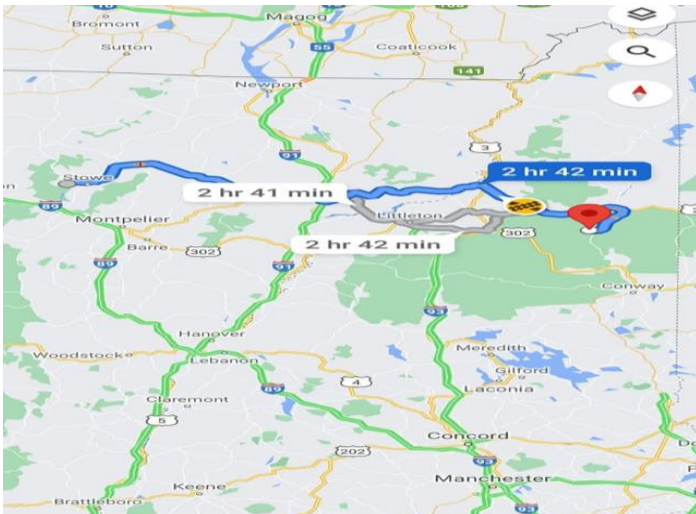


Day 2 - Head up the road to the Clark Art Museum in Williamstown. See more great American art. Return to the Red Lion.
